

Immanuel United Church of Christ
Annual Congregational Meeting
January 16, 2005

President Philip Jackson called the meeting to order stating that the purpose was to review the annual report for 2004. Pastor Evans led the members in an opening prayer celebrating a year of success for 2004.

Minutes of the Special Congregational Meeting of September 19, 2004 were reviewed; attention was brought to the addendum. Motion was made to accept the minutes: passed unanimously.

Minutes of the Budget/Election of President for 2005 held on October 17, 2004 were reviewed. Motion was made to accept the minutes: passed unanimously.

Following in our 2004 report books, a series of reports were reviewed and accepted from the pastor, president, CE Board, benevolence and special benevolence, missions, womens guild, youth fellowship, music and building repairs. All groups have been active and reported an excellent year. Spiritual council reported that they will consider a change in worship time in April. Appreciation was expressed to all for the fine reports and very active participation during the year.

Next we turned to financial reports, vision fund, investments, rental house and the building fund. Diana Jackson explained the various accounts where funds will be held.

The 2004 Proposed Budget and expenditures for the 2004 year were reviewed. There were no questions regarding this information.

Following the congregation reviewed the Gift Periods by Category, Memorial Fund, and the Financial Secretary's Report for 2004. Pastor Evans commended all who supported the church during the 2004 year; this was an outstanding giving year.

Next the congregation held elections for Church Council and the Christian Education Board.

Nominees for Church Council membership are Dr. William Bair, Karen Webster, and Kathy Kelly for a three-year term of service. Nominees for CE Board are Tammy Luthy and Susie Creighton for a two-year term of service. Claudia McDonald will remain on the Board for one-year additional service. Motion was made for the congregation to accept all five candidates for Church Council and CE Board: accepted by acclamation.
